WELCOME

Welcome back to North Beach Soccer Club for the 2017 season. We are pleased to advise that registrations are now open for returning members only. Any remaining places will be made available to new players from **February 1 2017**.

Please note that self-registration online is once again compulsory this year therefore Club volunteers will be unable to register for you. Please also note the following changes relevant to the 2017 season.

Ages 10/11 Based on feedback from previous years, Miniroos players in both the 10s and 11s year groups will now be aligned in teams with players of similar ability. This has become necessary to ensure we fully prepare our teams for transition to the junior competition. It is important to note that this is not a formal grading process and that input from coaches, the coaching coordinator and assessment of any new players will be also taken into account. If you have any concerns regarding this change, then please contact the coaching coordinator.

Uniforms All Miniroos will remain in the existing Kelme strip worn in 2016. Where possible kits should be retained from 2016 however existing players who need a new uniform will be given the chance to order when registrations are complete.

Juniors aged 12-18 will move to a new Nike shirt and shorts which are available in male and female cuts/sizes. Socks (if needed) can be purchased at \$10 each.

Fees In recognition of the difficulties facing many families in the current economic climate NBSC has elected not to pass on the annual increase in Football West registration fees. Fees will remain at the same level as 2016. We hope to undertake a number of fundraising activities during the year and strongly encourage participation from all families so that we may be a position to do the same in future years.

Please also note that local councils do offer assistance for sporting fees to eligible families by way of Kidsport vouchers. Information is available at www.dsr.wa.gov.au/funding/individuals/kidsport.

Please ensure you are familiar with our Club **grading** and **team allocation policies** as published on our website (www.nbsc.org.au) as all registrations assume acceptance of those policies.

How do I register ?

From 2015 Football West have required all registrations to be done online by the player or the player's parent or/guardian. Registrars are unable to log in and register for you so please read the instructions below carefully before proceeding with your registration.

1. Login:

- a) Go to the MyFootballClub website: www.myfootballclub.com.au
- b) Click on "Register Now"
- c) Select "Player Registration"
- d) Follow the prompts to proceed to login pages, find your FFA number and/or reset your password
- e) Login using your FFA number and password:
 - **FFA Number:**

2. Start Registration

- a) Once logged in, select "Make a Registration" or "Register Now"
- b) Update contact details if necessary.
- c) On the next screen, enter the club name (North Beach Soccer Club)
NB: If you get a message saying there are no packages then click OK and check the club name
- d) Select the Registration role as: "Player"
NB: If this is the first time you have registered to play football in Australia you will need to confirm whether you played in another country
- e) Select the correct Registration Package that applies to your registration. Please contact us at mail@nbsc.org.au if you are unsure. *The available options will be based on your age. Please ensure you select the correct age group*
- f) Click the "**Add**" button.
- g) Click the Next button at the bottom of the screen.
- h) Read and acknowledge the Terms and Conditions then click Next.
- i) Additional Items- Are you entitled to a Kidsport voucher ?
 - o If YES then click "Purchase additional items" and select "Kidsport "Voucher" for the voucher to be deducted from your fees.



You must be eligible for Kidsport in order to claim the deduction (please check your local council webpage for requirements). You will still need to complete and submit the application to your local council for validation. This is not the Club's responsibility and incomplete vouchers will not be accepted.

- j) Payment must be made online with Visa or Mastercard – follow the prompts to complete your payment. Registrations cannot be processed without payment. Your registration has now been submitted. If you are a new player you will need to email proof of age (birth certificate or passport) to mail@nbsc.org.au before we can accept your registration.
