Welcome back to North Beach Soccer Club (NBSC) for the 2017 season. We are pleased to advise that registrations are now open for returning members only. Any remaining places will be made available to new players from February 1 2017.

Please note that self-registration online is once again compulsory this year therefore Club volunteers will be unable to register for you.

The format of our program has changed for children aged <u>6-7</u> this year and our Club will return to the Football West Hub. This will include one training night as well as mini games (4 per side) against other local clubs on Sundays.

If you are a player in the 12-18s age group you will be prompted to provide or update your registration photo. Please ensure the photo shown is current so is able to be used to confirm your identity at games if required. Photos should be no more than 1 year old.

Local councils offer assistance for sporting fees to eligible families by way of Kidsport vouchers. Information is available at www.dsr.wa.gov.au/funding/individuals/kidsport.

Please ensure you are familiar with our Club grading and team allocation policies as published on our website (www.nbsc.org.au) as all registrations assume acceptance of those policies.

Training is likely to commence in March (subject to ground availability) with games to begin in April. Timetables are still being worked out with Football West and all registered players will be advised of team lists and training times once finalised.

The NBSC Committee is also looking for enthusiastic individuals who can help out in the area of sponsorship co-ordination and social media. If you have skills in these areas and would like to contribute, then please contact a committee member or email mail@nbsc.org.au.

How do I register?

From 2015 Football West have required all registrations to be done online by the player or the player's parent or/guardian. Registrars are <u>unable</u> to log in and register for you so please read the instructions below carefully before proceeding with your registration.

1. Login:

- a) Go to the MyFootballClub website: www.myfootballclub.com.au
- b) Click on "Register Now"
- c) Select "Player Registration"
- d) Follow the prompts to proceed to login pages, find your FFA number and/or reset your password
- e) Login using your FFA number and password:

2. Start Registration

- a) Once logged in, select "Make a Registration" or "Register Now"
- b) Update contact details if necessary.
- c) On the next screen, enter the club name (North Beach Soccer Club)

 NB: If you get a message saying there are no packages then click OK and check the club name
- d) Select the Registration role as: "Player"

 NB: If this is the first time you have registered to play football in Australia you will need to confirm whether you played in another country
- e) Select the correct Registration Package that applies to your registration. Please contact us at mail@nbsc.org.au if you are unsure. The available options will be based on your age. Please ensure you select the correct age group
- f) Click the "Add" button.
- g) Click the Next button at the bottom of the screen.
- h) Read and acknowledge the Terms and Conditions then click Next.
- i) Additional Items- Are you entitled to a Kidsport voucher?
 - If YES then click "Purchase additional items" and select "Kidsport "Voucher" for the voucher to be deducted from your fees.

You must be eligible for Kidsport in order to claim the deduction (please check your local council webpage for requirements). You will still need to complete and submit the application to your local council for validation. This is not the Club's responsibility and incomplete vouchers will not be accepted.

j) Payment must be made online with Visa or Mastercard – follow the prompts to complete your payment. Registrations cannot be processed without payment. Your registration has now been submitted. If you are a new player you will need to email proof of age (birth certificate or passport) to mail@nbsc.org.au before we can accept your registration.
